What's New For 2011:

Version 4.13.0 (available June 2011)

- Access to all updates from June 2011 through May 2012 (i.e., versions 4.13.1 - 4.13.xx)
- Live XML activation through July 2012

Version 4.12.1 - 4.12.12 (updates made from June 2010 - May 2011)

- Improve criteria for displaying "No other statistics" line in individual career history
- Add Support for entry of career-totals-only statistics (career totals for a player, without season-by-season stats for that era). To use this:
 1. Select Edit | Add new season
 2. Add a season for the last year of the player(s)
 3. Select Edit | Edit season data
 4. Check the "Contains career totals only" option
 5. Click the "Individual stats" button
 6. In the "Full roster" list click <New player>
 7. Enter the career totals for a player who last played in that year
 8. Repeat for other players as necessary
 9. Stats entered will be marked as "Contains career totals only", will be considered for individual career records, not individual season records.
- Fix to tab-stop output for career individual single-game highs
- Sort roster by uni number (on load roster)
- Clarify Edit season option as "Contains career totals only"
- Fix to "START" display in Summaries | Game participation report
- Fix to treat blocked punt past line of scrimmage as punt by "TM" (instead of an incidental "tip")
- Improve NCAA team code lookup function for game and season Xml, update NCAA team codes
- Add punting statistics to Team superlatives report
- Fix to use 9-yardline as redzone for AFL venue
- Add various scoring adjustments for Canadian rules venue

- For in-game scoring, calculate red zone attempts from the 20-yardline instead of the 19-yardline to comply with Ncaa statisticians guidelines (unless Rule control | Fumble as Ncaa = "N")
- For live game Xml, add "Retries after copy failure" option to Copy file settings section on Live setup window.
- Add "Touchdowns" and "Field goals" breakouts under Redzone Scores-Chances listing in Team statistics report
- Accommodate display in career/historical reports for results when W-L-T is known, but final score is unknown; in own-score/opp-score fields enter "99-0" for a win, "0-99" for a loss, and "99-99" for a tie
